
Memorandum of Understanding Between

APG (Alakh Prakash Goyal) Shimla University, India And Xinyu University, China

In accordance with the relevant Laws and Regulations of the People's Republic of China and India; two parties agree to sign a Memorandum of Understanding, based on the principles of mutual respect and mutual benefits and between APG (Alakh Prakash Goyal) Shimla University, India (hereinafter referred to as APG) and Xinyu University, China (hereinafter referred to as XYU). In order to improve and understand both Universities in education research and education concept, the two parties agree to carry out cooperation in teachers/students, and program information and resources exchanges.

I. In order to achieve two aspects demand in academic research and education, both parties will carry out the following exchange actives:-

1. Faculty and scholar exchange program (Professor, Instructor and Researcher)

According to mutual equivalence principle and waive fees (including training fees and accommodation), both parties agree to organize the relevant specialized teachers conducting exchange program, teaching studying between the two Universities. APG shall, according to its academic terms, offer all possible program teaching positions for faculty members of XYU conduction overseas teaching practice at APG, and provide free accommodation (Salary, flight ticket and visa fees shall be covered by XYU); XYU shall according to the above regulation and condition provide the relevant teaching positions for faculty members of APG conducting overseas teaching practice at XYU.

2. Student exchange program (including diploma students, undergraduates and graduates):-

In order to improve the communication and exchange between two Universities; In accordance with mutual equivalence principle and waive tuition fees, both parties agree to organize relevant major students conducting exchange program; APG shall according to its academic terms, arrange relevant major students to study the short term exchange and research program, language and credit course program.

3. Confucius Institute and other academic exchange program agreed by both parties.

II. This Memorandum of Understanding has been executed by both Universities; the terms and activities contained herein shall in any manner be binding upon the parties. In order to make the project smoothly, both parties shall provide all relevant support.

III. In the implementation of this MOU, both parties have their own respective autonomy, not any party shall be subjected to interference and limitations.

IV. This MOU goes into effect after signed by both Universities representative. The validity of this MOU is five years.

V. Any revisions to the MOU should be agreed on both parties. Either party intends to terminate this MOU shall discuss with other party and provide written notice, to avoid inconvenience factors may occur.

VI. This MOU exists in both English and Chinese version, each with a total of 2 Copies, which have the equal legal effect.
